GİRİŞ

Ahlâkin Yayını Bükmek

21 Mart Pazar, 1965. Selma, Alabama

Yaklaşık 8.000 kişi Brown Şapeli’nde buluşup Selma kasabasından Alabama eyaletinin Montgomery şehrine doğru yürüyüse geçti. Göstericiler çoğunlukla Afrikalı-Amerikalılardan* oluşuyorlardı ve eyalet meclisine yürümelerinin tek nedeni vardı: *adalet*. Tek talepleri oy kullanma hakkının kendilerine verilmesiydi. Fakat bu mücadelelerinde yalnız degillerdi. ABD’nin neredeyse her eyaletinden, “her ırktan, dinden ve her sınıfından” göstericiler, siyah kardeşleriyle birlikte yürümek için bir araya gelmişlerdi. En ön safta ise halkını Mısır’dan çıkarılan Musa misali bu yürüyüse önderlik eden, Nobel Barış Ödülü sahibi vaiz ve insan hakları savunucusu, din adamı Marthin Luther King Jr. bulunu-yordu.

Silahlı polisler ve çevik kuvvetle desteklenmiş ırkçı bir müdafahlenin kıs-kaçında, göstericiler daha önce de iki kere yürümeyi denemişler fakat her de-fasında eyalet polisi ve diğer kolluk kuvvetlerinin sert müdahalesiyle dağıtılmışlardı. “Kanlı Pazar” diye de bilinen ilk seferde, yürüyüşçüler geri dönme-leri konusunda yetkililer tarafından uyarılmışlar fakat bu uyarıyı gözden gel-mişler ve kolluk kuvvetlerine alkış tutan, tezahüratta bulunan seyircilerin huzurunda gaz bombalarına maruz kalmışlar, coplar ve dikenli teller sarılmış sopalarla darp edilmişlerdi. İkinci girişimlerinde yine çok sayıda eyalet polisi tarafından karşılaşmışlar, geri dönmemeleri yönünde uyarı almışlar, bunun üz-erine King dua etmek için izin istemiş ve ardından göstericileri yollarından döndürmüştü.

Fakat bu kez iş başkaydı. Bu kez Başkan Lyndon B. Johnson tehlike sin-yallerinin farkına erken varıp başlarında komutanlarıyla birlikte 2.000 askerin

yürüyüşçülere eşlik etmesi emrini vermişti. Yürüyüşüler bu sayede bu kez yollarına devam edebildiler. Beş gün ve 85 kilometrelilik yol boyunca, iliklerine işleyen soğuğa ve sağanak yağışa rağmen yürüdüler. Haber yayıldıkça göstericilerin sayısı katlanarak arttı. 25 Mart günü eyalet meclisinin kapısına dayandıklarında sayıları 25.000'i bulmuştu.

Gelgelelim King'in eyalet meclis binasının basamaklarına dahi adım atmasına izin verilmemi. Yürüyüşçüler kamu mülküne alınmadılar. Meclisin çatısı altında Roma valisi Pontuslu Pilatus misali makamına kurulmuş George Wallace, dışarı çıkmayı ve yürüyüşçülere seslenmeyi reddetti. Bunun üzerine Dr. King meclisin önüne park etmiş bir kamyonun kasasına kurulan derme çatma bir kürsüden göstericilere seslenip özgürlük marşı haline gelen o ünlü konuşmasını yaptı. Sözlerine "derin vadileri"^{*} hep birlikte aşip "taşlı sapa yollarda" dinlendiklerini, güneşte birlikte kavrulup çamurlar içinde hep beraber yattıklarını, yağmurla iliklerine kadar birlikte islandıklarını anlatarak başladı. King, özgürlük arayışıyla ABD'nin dört bir yanından gelen kalabalığa, şiddet içermeyen sivil itaatsizlik felsefesinden şaşmamalarını salık veriyordu çünkü ezilen halkların sabrının bir sınırının olduğunu, tokat yiyenin tokat atmaya daima meyilli olduğunu gayet iyi biliyordu. Göstericiler King'i can kulağıyla dinlediler. King, cevabını bildiği şu soruları onlara sordu: "Ön yargı insan gözünü kör etmeye daha ne kadar devam edecek?" "Zihni daha ne kadar bulandıracak?" "Gözleri işil işil parlayan bilgeligi kutlu tahtından daha ne kadar mahrum bırakacak?" "Adalet çarmıhta daha ne kadar kalacak ve o çarmıh hakikate daha ne kadar taşıtılacak?"

Dr. King, bu sorulara cevap olarak teskin ve temin edici nasihatlerde bulunuyordu: Ne kadar engellenmeye çalışılırsa çalışılsın özgürlük önünde sonunda gerçekleşecekti. Bu iddiasını dini benzettmeler ve İncil'den yaptığı alıntılarla gerçekçelendiriyordu: "Yerle yeksan hakikat er geç tekrar şahlanacak,"^{**} "Hiçbir yalan sonsuza dek süremez," "İnsan ne ekerse onu biçer"^{***} ve "Evrensel ahlâkin yayı uzundur ama daima adalete doğru büklülür."³

Bu konuşma, Dr. King'in kariyerindeki en büyük vaazlardan biriydi. Hatta hitabet sanatının tarihteki en iyi örneklerinden biri olduğu dahi söylenebilir. Dahası işe yaradı. Beş aydan kısa bir süre içinde, 6 Ağustos 1965'te, başkan Johnson siyahların oy kullanma hakkını yasalaştıran değişikliği imzaladı. Dr. King'in söylediğinin doğru çıkmıştı. Evrensel ahlâkin yayı uzundu fakat adalete doğru büklüyordu.

Dr. King'in atıfta bulunduğu ve bu kitabın başlığının da esin kaynağı olan yukarıdaki söz, 19. yüzyılda yaşamış kölelik karşıtı vaiz Theodore Par-

ker'a ait. Parker ahlâkî iyimserlik hakkındaki yazısını 1853 yılında, tam da lağvedilmesini arzuladığı kölelik kurumu yüzünden ABD'nin hızla bir iç savaşa doğru sürüklendiği, kötümserlik deryasında boğulduğu bir dönemde kaleme almıştı.

Evrensel ahlâkî tamamen anlıyormuş gibi davranışımın yanı uzun, gözlerimse onun yalnızca bir kısmını görüyor. Kavisinin nerde bittiğini hesaplayamıyor, şeklin tamamını kestiremiyorum; onu ancak vicdanımla sezıyorum. Ama gördüğüm kadarıyla şu kadarını söyleyebilirim ki kesinlikle adalete doğru bükülüyorum.⁴

Ahlâkîn Yayı'nda amacım Rahip Parker ile Martin Luther King'in haklı oluklarını, evrensel ahlâkîn yayının gerçekten de adalete doğru büküldüğünü göstermek. Fakat ahlâkîn yayının izini dinsel vicdanda ve hitabet sanatında sürebileceğimiz gibi, bilgiye ulaşmak için kullanabileceğimiz birçok sorgulama kanalına sahip bilim aracılığıyla da sürebiliriz. Bu sorgulama kanallarının tümü, genel olarak insanlığın her geçen gün biraz daha ahlâkî hale geldiğini bize gösteriyor. Üstelik son birkaç yüzyıl içinde ahlak alanında yaşanan gelişmelerin dinsel kuvvetlerin eseri olmayıp büyük oranda dünyevi kuvvetlerin eseri olduğunu, Akıl Çağrı'nda ve Aydınlanma döneminde sahneye çıkan bu kuvvetlerin en önemlilerinin akıl ile bilim olduğunu ileri sürüyorum. Burada akıl ve bilim terimlerinden savların akıl yürütütmelerle sınanıp deneyler aracılığıyla doğrulanmasını anlıyorum.

Dahası, evrensel ahlâkîn yayının sadece adalete doğru bükülmekle kalmayıp hakikate ve özgürlüğe doğru da büküldüğünü ve bu konuda ulaşılan olumlu sonuçların büyük ölçüde daha seküler yönetim, siyaset, yasa ve hukuk, ahlâkî akıl yürütme ve etik çözümleme tarzlarına yöneltmiş toplumların ürünleri olduğunu da ortaya koyuyorum. Zamanla, benim inançlarım, ahlâk kurallarım, yaşam tarzım ve geleneklerimin sadece bana ait oldukları için ya da benim tanım Tek Tanrı olduğu ve sizinki öyle olmadığı için ya da benim ulusum sizin ulusunuzun canına okuyabilecek kuvvette ve imkânlarla sahip olduğu için başkasının kinden daha iyi olduğunu iddia etmek daha az kabul edilir hale geldi. Artık kendi inançlarını *dayatmak* diye birsey yok; bunları *gereklendirmeniz* gerekiyor ve bu gereklilikleri de akıl yürütütmelere ve deneysel kanita dayandırmalısınız. Aksi halde bunlar ya önemsenmezler ya da reddedilirler.

Tarihe baktığımızda ara sıra yaşanan kesintilere rağmen ahlak küresini türümüzün diğer mensuplarını da –hatta başka türleri bile– toplumumuzun meşru üyeleri sayıp kapsayacak şekilde istikrarlı biçimde genişlettigimizi görüyoruz. İnsanlığın filizlenen vicdanı bugün öyle bir noktaya geldi ki artık sadece ailemizin, akrabalarımızın, yakın çevremizin iyiliğini düşünmüyorum. Bizden hayli farklı olan, mal ve fikir alışverişi yapmaktan keyif aldığımız,
